Solar Panel Donation Form

Goal

- Partner with the Verona Area School District to raise \$500,000 to install a 500-panel solar array on the Verona High School roof. This array will generate approximately
- 300 kW of electricity - enough to power a significant portion of the school's energy needs.

Why It Matters?

- Global warming, driven by the burning of fossil fuels, is a serious threat and getting worse. We need to switch to cleaner energy sources including solar power.
- Carbon dioxide produced from combustion and methane ("natural gas") are the main contributors to climate change.
- A solar array of this size will prevent the release of about 200 tons of carbon dioxide each year. It will substantially reduce the school's methane consumption.

Additional Benefits

- The solar array will save the school thousands of dollars annually in energy costs.
- The solar array will pay for itself within 10 years and save the school district almost \$1 million over its 30-year life.
- An educational display in the school will help raise awareness among students and the community about global warming and clean energy solutions.
